Development Update

Doohan Reserve - the reserve was partially opened to the public in April with the fields and main club house handed over to Council and the Oran Park Rovers Football Club.

The remaining works to the tennis courts and the all abilities playground, are nearing completion and are expected to be finalised in the next two weeks, weather permitting. This will conclude the works to the reserve.

An opening event will be organised in conjunction with Camden Council,

to celebrate the completion of this facility.

Oran Park Podium - Development Application (DA) for Podium Stage 3A has been lodged with Camden Council. The DA proposes to expand the retail shopping to over double the size of the existing retail area. Preparation continues on the DA for Podium Stage 3B which includes a hotel. This is expected to be lodged in the third quarter of 2021.

Oran Park Tavern - road works continue near the site with kerbing to be completed shortly. The operators continue to work through applications for liquor and gaming licences and are preparing their CC

documentation targeting construction to commence in the third quarter of 2021.

Service Station - the DA has now been approved and the operator is currently working through CC documentation aiming to start construction in August. The service station is expected to open early 2022.

Employment Zone - Stage 1 civil works continue with drainage works still continuing on site. Early preparation work has commenced for the construction of The Northern Road slip lane. The DA for the Stage 2 bulk earthworks has been lodged with Camden Council and will go on exhibition shortly.

Oran Park Leisure Centre - Camden Council continue to finalise DA documentation with construction expected to commence in 2022.

The leisure centre will be located in the civic precinct next to Oran Park Library and will include a 50m pool and leisure/learn to swim pool, 4 basketball courts, gym and underground car park.

The facility will be delivered by Camden Council with funds and input provided by Greenfields Development Company.

Julia Creek - civil works are close to being finished in Julia Creek, adjacent to Oran Park High School and Oran Park Public School. Landscaping and bush regeneration works will then follow with work expected to be completed July/August 2021.

Once complete, Julia Creek will provide improved pedestrian connectivity in the town centre.

Banfield Drive basin - civil works are close to being finished with landscaping and bush regeneration works to follow. Work is expected to be completed by the end of August 2021.



Metro apartments – construction is progressing well with work now commencing on forming up the floor slab for level 4 of the 7 storey residential building located opposite TRN House.

Tranche 29, Stage 4 (east of Madden Street) – subdivision works are on track, with our contractor, TRN, continuing with civil works and the installation of retaining walls. Work will commence soon on the bioretention basin and open space.

Perkins Drive park - the development approval for this pocket park has been obtained. The application for a CC to allow construction to begin will be submitted soon. Works will commence once this approval has been obtained.

Fordham Way extension - approvals have been received and work has commenced on the extension of Fordham Way to Oran Park Drive which will provide improved access to the residential and commercial buildings as well as the future service station.

COVID-19 Vaccinations

COVID-19 vaccinations are currently available to everyone in Australia over the age of 50 as well as people under 50 in vulnerable groups.

NSW Health is also taking bookings for people aged 40 to 49 years at its Pfizer sites across the state, including its Liverpool hub.

Check your vaccine eligibility at https://covid-

vaccine.healthdirect.gov.au/eligibility and if eligible, book an appointment.

The vaccine is voluntary and everyone is encouraged to get a vaccine to help protect the community from COVID-19.

Bowel Cancer Awareness Month

June is Bowel Cancer Awareness Month - Australia's second deadliest cancer.



Bowel cancer kills more people in NSW than prostate cancer, breast cancer or melanoma. Despite this, currently only around 40% of eligible people in NSW take part in the National Bowel Cancer Screening Program.

ACCINATION

The Program is an Australian Government initiative that sends out free bowel cancer screening tests to eligible Australians aged 50-74 every two years.

Bowel cancer screening can detect cancers at an earlier stage when treatment can be more successful. If detected early, bowel cancer can be successfully treated in more than 90% of cases.

There is a lot that can be done if bowel cancer is detected early, so when you receive your test in the mail, be sure to do it and send it back.
