Development Updates

Open Space

Julia Creek

We expect to finalise handover mid this year and once this is done the area will be open to the public and will give a new pedestrian connection to Jack Brabham Reserve.

Baseball Facility

DA assessment continues for the new baseball facility near Barramurra Public School which Stage 1 of the facility includes a full-size competition baseball field, amenities building and car park.

Bulk earthworks on site will likely commence mid 2022 in readiness for the civil works and building works to commence towards the end of the year. The facility will be delivered in stages and the target to complete Stage 1 of the facility is early-mid 2023.

Tranche 34 northern basin

Construction continues on the northern basin – north of Peter Brock Drive - with landscaping contract works starting shortly. The basin fulfills a water quantity and quality function which treats stormwater before discharging in South Creek.

Oran Park Podium

Early bulk earthworks are now complete on Podium Stage 3A. Mainbrace have been appointed as the building contractor and they are now established on site.

Approvals are in place to commence building works which include footings, columns and ground floor

Stage 3A is located directly to the north of the existing shopping centre and will include some exciting new retail spaces including a Coles supermarket, a large childcare centre and significant upgrades to Podium Way, making way for an improved outdoor dining precinct.

Stage 3A is expected to be completed by the end of 2023.

The DA for Stage 3C of the Podium has been approved for a temporary park. Stage 3C is the landscaping treatment along Oran Park Drive and is part of the Stage 3 Podium shopping centre expansion.

Stage 3C will provide another major pedestrian entry to the Podium from Oran Park Drive and will provide a new public domain and play area.

The playground will feature a safe play area for children with the inclusion of enclosed play areas, a variety of climbing equipment and children's water play to facilitate challenging and exciting experiences for all ages.

Landscaped gardens and seating will provide a series of attractive spaces for meeting, eating and playing, creating a strong sense of place and community.

Stage 3C is expected to open at the same time as Stage 3A, late in 2023. For retail leasing enquiries please email commercial@greenfields.





Metro North apartments

Building and landscaping works are now complete. Registration is expected in June/July with the first residents anticipated to start moving in August.

Metro Central apartments

Richard Crookes have been appointed as the building contractors for the second apartment building. They established on site in May and in-ground works are expected to commence in June.

Metro Central is a 66 apartment building with a few apartments still available for sale.

3 Fordham Way

After experiencing delays following the extreme wet weather, works have now progressed to basement 3 level with in-ground piling and servicing almost complete. The basement level 3 slab is next and will continue to come out of the ground.

Completion is expected mid-2023 with new office suites now available for sale or lease.

Oran Park Leisure Centre

TRN continue with early works on site and Council are currently out to tender for the building contractor.

This project includes a 50m indoor swimming pool, leisure and learn to swim pool, spa and sauna, four indoor multipurpose courts, gym and 2 program rooms, crèche, cafè and underground carparking. The project is co-funded by Greenfields Development Company and Camden Council.

The Leisure Centre building is expected to be completed late 2024.

Oran Park Hotel (opposite Dawson Damer Park)

Work has been slowly progressing after delays due to the significant wet weather. The basement car park is largely excavated with shoring works complete.

Thompson Health Care

Building works are nearing completion and the centre is expected to open in June subject to receiving Occupation Certificate.

Service Station (Peter Brock Drive)

Work has been completed on the new service station and it is now open. The service station will operate 24/7 and accepts Woolworths **Everyday Rewards Cards** and AmpolCard.

The site includes an Oliver's food store serving healthy and wholesome fast food and organic coffee. Open every day with options to drive thru, takeaway or dine in.

Employment Zone

A development application has been lodged for a second service station located adjacent to The Northern Road in Stage 1 of the Employment Zone. This is in addition to the applications already lodged for a Rent A Space, second Oran Park Tavern, Bulky Goods Centre and KFC. Work has also commenced on the new fire station located on the corner of Dick Johnson Drive and Southwell Road.

Stage 2 of the Employment Zone has bulk earthworks underway and construction certificate documentation is being prepared in readiness to commence civil works for 25 industrial uses.

Tranche 27, Stage 3

Civil works continue on the 51 lot subdivision with work expected to be completed mid 2022. Asphalt is complete and landscape preparation works are underway. Registration is expected in October 2022.

Children with a disability

Any child that may need extra support in a mainstream class, or who will be enrolled in a support class or School for Specific Purposes, must be enrolled before the end of Term 2 (Friday 1st July 2022). This is the cut-off date for applications, which are made through your local primary school.

Early contact with the school ensures an individualised transition program is in place and the school has the information they need to support your child.


tea and coffee Wednesday and Thursday as well as a hot community breakfast on Friday mornings.
