ORAN PARK TOWN NEWS

Development Update

Earthworks continue on the site of the skate park, located opposite the Sales and Information Centre. The skate park will have multiple zones including a skate trail, multi-purpose court and kickabout space. Construction is underway and expected completion in late 2019.

Construction Access for the new Youth and Recreation Building, which is located next to the skate park, is currently under construction. Residents may have noticed a partial lane closure on Peter Brock Drive to facilitate this access. Construction of the Youth and Recreation Building was to commence in October, however a new builder has now been appointed and construction is to commence in December 2018.

Parks

A Development Application is to be lodged for the new park near the about to be decommissioned pumping station in Perkins Drive adjacent to South Creek. This new section of open space is expected to include a fitness station, seating and walking paths.

Work will commence in the New Year in Anthony Creek adjoining the substation and the Northern Road, providing a new natural creek area, pathways and open space.

Following on from Council's adoption of changes to the Planning Agreement in relation to Mick Doohan Reserve, the Development Application is progressing well and is expected to be determined before the end of the year. Construction is expected to commence in January.

Roads

Dick Johnson Drive extension works are being finalised with connection to the Northern Road expected in 2019 and is subject to works being undertaken by the Roads and Maritime Services on The Northern Road.







Civil works continue on the section of Dick Johnson Drive from Brabham Reserve to Oran Park Drive and the bridge over Julia Reserve is taking shape. This section is expected to be opened early 2019.

Work is progressing well on the section of Dick Johnson Drive from Oran Park Drive to South Circuit north of the town centre has been issued and work has commenced.

Now that most homes are complete in many streets of Oran Park, the final layer of asphalt is currently being placed. Similarly, remaining footpaths and street trees are being installed now that most building work in these areas have been completed. This work continues.

Construction Update

The civil construction of Tranche 9, located at the corner of Peter Brock Drive and South Circuit is complete.



Landscaping works are also nearing completion. The subdivision certificate package is with Council and it is anticipated that registration will occur this year.

Construction of architecturally designed terrace homes in Tranche 1 is progressing well. This site was selected given its proximity to the Town Centre and other amenities such as Gardner Reserve. Construction of the

first terraces within Tranche 7 is well underway and civil works continue in and around Tranche 7 particularly in Julia Creek and Reserve.

Construction has commenced on a six storey commercial building opposite the Sales Office car park. The new building will offer businesses the opportunity to purchase a commercial space in the town centre and will help generate more local employment





opportunities. For sales enquiries please contact the Sales Office on 9043 7500.

A Development Application was lodged with Camden Council in October for the second stage of Oran Park Podium. The project is a mixed-use development including shopping, offices and apartments. We believe this project will make Oran Park Town more vibrant and continue with the realisation of Oran Park Town's Centre.

If you were unable to attend the October Community Update and recent Podium Stage 2 drop in sessions but would like more information on the project, please contact the Sales Office on 9043 7500.

A Development Application has recently been lodged with Camden Council for Rons Creek Stage 1, a large recreational space to the north of the town centre. This exciting project will have a large water play area which is being jointly funded with Camden

Council. Other features include a separate youth and junior play areas, formal park, picnic area with BBQ facilities and amenities building.

In November, Thompson Health Care lodged a Development Application with Camden Council for a three storey, 240 bed aged care facility to be built to the east of Brabham Reserve.

Free Pool Entry for Teens

Teenagers living in the Camden area are eligible for free entry to Camden War Memorial Pool and Mount Annan Leisure Centre during the month of January in the school holidays. The Cool Off in Camden program is run by Camden Council's Youth Services to encourage outdoor activity for young residents aged between 12 and 18 years or in school years 7 to 12.

Young people are required to collect an access card that provides free entry for up to eight visits in total between 1 - 31 January 2019. Access cards can be collected by a parent of the young person or the young person themselves from Camden and Narellan Libraries, the Council Administration Building in Oran Park or at either of the swimming pools from Monday 3 December 2018. Places are limited so get in quick.

It is recommended that card holders arrive early at each pool to avoid disappointment. There is a limit of 30 free places per day at each pool. It's a

good idea for young people to bring some money with them just in case. Cards will not be re-issued if they are lost – strictly one per person. Young people aged 12 - 14 years must be accompanied at the pool by a paying adult.

Home Security over the Holidays

Are you planning a holiday?

Many break and enter offences occur during the holiday season. A large number occur when your home appears to look unlived in and it becomes obvious that no one is home. Here are some safety tips if you are planning a holiday:

- Check everything is locked and secured before leaving. Lock ALL windows, doors, garden sheds, gates, garages and any other area of your home that are able to be secured.
- Ask a friend or neighbour to park in your driveway.

- Ask a trusted friend or neighbour to collect your mail and to occasionally check on your home while away.
- Make sure the lawn does not become overgrown.
- Stop all deliveries.
- Ensure your phone message doesn't state that you are away on holidays and be careful what you post on social media.
- When packing for a holiday, avoid packing your vehicle the night before as it will become an attractive target for a thief.

If you notice any suspicious behaviour, please report it and if safe to do so note any vehicle registrations.
