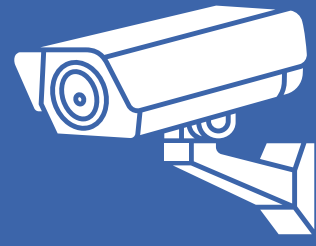


# CCTV FAQs



## Oran Park Closed Circuit Television System

### What is Oran Park CCTV system?

CCTV system is a Closed Circuit Television network that has been installed on public land at major facilities and major entry points in Oran Park to strengthen community security. This is achieved by deterring criminal activity and improving the ability for our local Police to investigate potential crimes. This in turn will provide safer facilities for the community to enjoy and access the footage.

### Where is Oran Park CCTV system installed?

- Dawson-Damer Park Water Play Space & Playground
- Doohan Reserve All Abilities Playground
- Entry and exit points to Oran Park suburb
- Julia Reserve Youth Precinct
- Podium Way
- Perich Park within Town Centre

### Why do we have a CCTV system?

Installation of CCTV system is a Smart Cities initiative, its aims to use technology to improve the quality of life of residents. CCTV system is consistent with Council's goals of promoting community security and crime prevention.

### What is in place to protect my privacy rights?

Camden Council has developed a CCTV Communications Policy designed to balance the need for community security and crime prevention with the protection of privacy rights. The policy reflects the Council's commitment to transparency, data security, and accountability. The Oran Park Community Association also has a CCTV policy which complies with Council policy.

### Who can access the footage?

Camden Police and Town Centre manager. When investigating a potential crime Camden Police will formally request footage through the Oran Park Town Centre manager as a representative of the Community Association.

### Who is involved in the CCTV System?

Opticomm (telecommunication provider) installed & maintains this system, Greenfields Development Company co-funded the system, Camden Council are landowners, Oran Park Community Association are the owners and Camden Police has limited access to the footage in the event of investigating a potential crime.

### What is the footage used for?

Camden Police can download and use the footage as evidence in an investigation of crime.

### How long is the recorded footage stored for?

Footage retention policy is to be stored for 31 days, then is deleted.

### Can I access the CCTV footage for a lost wallet or damage to my property?

No, only Camden Police relating to a potential crime can access the footage.
